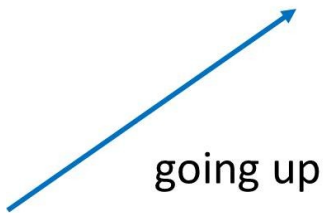

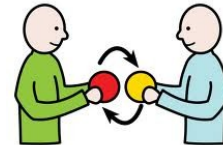
A written promise by a company to repair or change a product that develops a fault within a particular period of time.

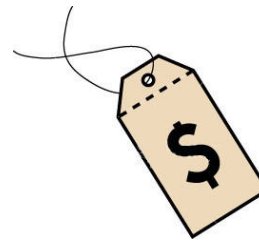
To bring down to a smaller extent, size, amount, number, etc.; to lower in price.
